Directions

By car: MAKE SURE TO OBTAIN PARKING PASS UPON ENTRY TO HOTEL LOT! – PARK IN REAR
From the South via New Jersey Turnpike

- Turnpike North to exit 14
- Follow sign to US Route 1/9 South...stay in Local Lane, not Express Lane (very important)
- Continue on US Route 1/9 South past the Anheuser Busch/Budweiser Brewery
- Before the Hilton, take the exit for the Service Road
- Slowly pass Hilton Hotel and Hampton Inn and turn into next drive way

From the North via New Jersey Turnpike

- Turnpike South to exit 14
- Follow sign to US Route 1/9 South...stay in Local Lane, not Express Lane (very important)
- Continue on US Route 1/9 South past the Anheuser Busch/Budweiser Brewery
- Before the Hilton, take the exit for the Service Road
- Slowly pass Hilton Hotel and Hampton Inn and turn into next drive way

From the West via I-78

- Take I-78 East to exit 57 for US Route 1/9 South and Newark Airport
- Stay left for 1/9 South (Main Terminal)
- Follow signs for 1/9 South (Local Lane, not Express Lane...very important)
- Before the Hilton, take the exit for the Service Road
- Slowly pass Hilton Hotel and Hampton Inn and turn into next drive way

From the North via Garden State Parkway

- Take the Garden State Parkway South to exit 143B
- Turn right at the first light
- Take right at the next light
- Follow the road for a couple of miles until you see exit for 78 East (on the left)
- Take 78 East to exit 57
- Follow signs for 1/9 South (Local Lane, not Express Lane...very important)
- Before the Hilton, take the exit for the Service Road
- Slowly pass Hilton Hotel and Hampton Inn and turn into next drive way

From the South via Garden State Parkway

- Take the Garden State Parkway North to exit 142
- Take 78 East to exit 57
- Follow signs for 1/9 South (Local Lane, not Express Lane...very important)
- Before the Hilton, take the exit for the Service Road
- Slowly pass Hilton Hotel and Hampton Inn and turn into next drive way

By train AMTRAK or NJ Transit:

Arrive at the Newark Airport Station, then locate the airport monorail and take it to station P4. The hotel shuttle bus picks up every 20 minutes and it is a 10 minute ride to the hotel. Taxi from the train station to the hotel may also be available; check signage.

Alternate arrival at Penn Station Newark: take a taxi from the lower level to the hotel (about \$25).

By Air to EWR Newark Liberty International Airport:

From your arrival terminal, locate the airport monorail and take it to station P4. The hotel shuttle bus picks up every 20 minutes and it is a 10 minute ride to the hotel. Taxi to the hotel; proceed to the lower level of your terminal (\$18 to hotel, \$25 return to terminal).
