# JOHN VICKERS, DIVISION CHIEF OF WESTERN OPERATIONS NYC DEP TO ADDRESS POST AT ANNUAL ELECTIONS MEETING ON JUNE 6, 2012

John has over 26 years of experience in leading engineering and construction management organizations at increasing levels of responsibility and authority. As the Division Chief of Western Operations Division in the NYC Department of Environmental Protection, Bureau of Water Supply, John leads 140 managers, engineers, technicians, supervisors and skilled and unskilled laborers organized into 3 regions covering a 1500 square mile area and is responsible for the operations and maintenance of 6 large water supply reservoirs, 14 high hazard classified dams and dikes, more than 100 water supply facilities and administrative buildings including two power generating hydro-electric facilities, 130,000 acres of watershed lands, 95 miles of City maintained public highways, 33 bridges, and 142 miles of aqueduct.

Prior to joining the DEP in 2006, John served 20 years as an engineer officer in the US Army. Among his awards and decorations is the Bronze De Fleury medal for his service in the Corps of Engineers and award of Department Head Emeritus by the President of Northern Michigan University for his service leading its Military Science Department. John earned his Bachelor of Science in civil engineering from the US Military Academy and Master of Science in civil engineering from the University of Colorado. He is a licensed engineer in the Commonwealth of Virginia and in New York State.

John, his wife Bethany of 23 years, and sons Teddy and Paul live in Delhi, NY. John coaches the Delhi Youth Soccer under 13 travel team which currently includes his two boys, is a member of Kiwanis and the American Legion and enjoys

all forms of hunting and fishing. His freezer is usually well stocked with venison, turkey, grouse and fish.


#### NYC POST TO ELECT OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS FOR 2012—2013
