NYC POST WITH NJ POST SUPPORT ARE PLEASED TO WELCOME WILLIAM GOLDSTEIN, SENIOR ADVISOR TO THE (NYC) MAYOR FOR RECOVERY, RESILIENCY AND INFRASTRUCTURE ON WEDNESDAY EVENING, FEBRUARY 25, 2015 AT THE HARVARD CLUB

Bill Goldstein has been managing major New York City infrastructure programs since 1983. In his current capacity as Senior Advisor to the Mayor for Recovery, Resiliency, and Infrastructure, Bill oversees the City's Housing Recovery Office, the Office of Recovery and Resiliency, the Office of Sustainability and general infrastructure policy.

Bill previously served as Executive Vice President at the MTA Capital Construction Company, which implemented the agency's \$16 billion mega-project program that includes the Fulton Street Transit Center, the Second Avenue Subway and the East Side Access Project. In 2003, he was appointed President and CEO of the New York City School Construction Authority. During his tenure, he developed and managed the City's unprecedented \$12 billion Capital Program to rebuild schools and add new facilities for the New York City Department of Education.

In addition, Bill has served as Director of Capital Program Management at the MTA and Deputy Executive Director for Capital Programs for the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey. At the Port Authority, he played a key role in rebuilding the World Trade Center complex after the 1993 attack. Bill also held senior management positions at two major New York City consulting firms, Parsons Brinckerhoff and URS.

Bill has a B.S. in Economics from The Wharton School of the University of Pennsylvania and a Masters Degree in City Planning from the University of Pennsylvania. He and his wife live in Brooklyn. They have two children.
